2010 SQ JUNIOR PRESIDENT'S SHIELD TEAM ROLL OFF ACCREDITATION NUMBER A09/0206



The Junior Interstate President's Shield Competition is the biggest annual junior 5 bowler Team event in Australia. 10 Teams representing all States, Territories and Zones across Australia compete against each other to be the Champion Team.

The members of the South Queensland Team will be determined by **two** separate Roll-Offs over 12 games each. At the conclusion of the 2nd roll-off 6 boys and girls will be announced as the 2010 South Queensland Junior Interstate President's Shield Team.

The 39th Australian Junior Nationals, incorporating the President's Shield will be held from 3rd – 17th April at Werribee Superbowl, 13 Riverside Avenue, Werribee Victoria.

Eligibility:

1. Must not have reached eighteen (18) on the 1st January 2010.
2. Must be a current financial member of a TBA licensed association or registered bowling centre in the South Queensland zone. TBA Registered Player cards, or proof of purchase, must be shown at check-in on day one.
3. Must reside in the South Queensland zone.
4. Must have competed in at least eight weeks of league competition and bowled a minimum of 24 games in a TBA Accredited League in the South Queensland zone, during the current year. League games completed post-pre bowl do not count towards the number of games bowled.
5. Must reside in South Queensland Zone for a period of time that enables participation in the Roll-Off and if successful in making the Team must continue league play in an accredited league. Requests for exemption to this rule must be in writing to the TBA (refer TBA eligibility criteria).
6. Be capable of conduct that does not adversely affect TBA of the State of QLD.

Conditions:

1. No nominations will be accepted unless the form is:
 - Signed by the League Secretary
 - Signed by the bowler and their parent/guardian.
2. All parents/legal guardians agree by signing the Nomination Form that they accept the following rules and conditions when their child becomes a member of the South Queensland Team.
 - Pay the initial fee of \$500 (non-refundable) to the Treasurer of the South Queensland Junior Committee on a due date as finalised on the last day of Roll-Off.
 - Pay all other monies in excess of the \$500 in installments on the due dates set out by the Committee. The total monies are divided by the 12 team players.
 - Abide by all rules and any instructions given by the Committee and its' delegated officials at any function, Tournament or training session.
3. The parent/legal guardian will ensure that the bowler will:
 - Attend and be punctual at all official training sessions as designated by the Coaches. A training schedule will be implemented by the coaches and comprise compulsory training sessions and tournaments.
 - Attend all uniform fitting sessions and wear the official training/team uniform when directed,
 - Travel with the Team as requested by the Team management.
 - Assist in the fundraising or activities set by the Committee.

General Rules:

- All TBA rules and regulations will apply including the TBA Code of Ethics.
- Any bowler failing to complete any stage of the Roll-Off will not be entitled to a refund of any monies paid, and will be considered as withdrawing from the event. Bowlers withdrawing due to injury or illness will remain eligible for selection.
- Bowlers must wear neat, acceptable bowling attire, collared shirt, dress pants for boys and dress pants/shorts or skirts for girls. No caps, half/three quarter length pants, jeans cargo pants or sport style tops will be acceptable.
- Smoking is prohibited during a series or session of continuous games in any competition accredited by TBA or any organisation, Committee or Bowling Centre recognised by TBA.
- Applications for **exemption** to any rules, or eligibility criteria, are to be in writing to the Secretary, South Queensland Junior Committee, and post marked no later than Friday 31st July 2009.

Format:

- Qualifying will be held in two divisions, Boys and Girls. A total of 12 games will be completed in the **1st Roll-Off due to be held at Logan City Tenpin Bowl on the 8th/9th August 2009.**
- Saturday Check-in: 11:30am Bowl: 12noon
Sunday Check-in: 10:30am Bowl: 11am
- At the completion on the 12 games completed at Logan City Tenpin Bowl the 10 highest bowlers (based on pinfall) will be selected to be part of the South Queensland Junior President's Shield Training Squad.
- The 2nd Roll-Off will be held at Caboolture Tenpin Bowl over 12 games February 6th/7th, pinfall will not be carried over.
- As per new regulations from TBA, the following criteria will apply for the second roll-off

In the event that a State/Territory decides it will have a team of 6 bowlers, qualifying roll-off where the first four highest pinfall bowlers in the roll-off in male and female Divisions will be declared as members of the President's Junior Interstate Shield Team. A further two will be selected for each Division. All bowlers that have submitted a nomination for the event are available for selection, regardless of whether they participated in the roll-off or not.

Nominations:

- A nomination fee of \$100.00 (non-refundable) must accompany all entries.
- All entries and nomination fees must be post marked no later than Friday 31st July 2009. No entries after this date will be accepted.
- All games fees (\$75.00) must be paid in full to the Secretary at Check-in on the 1st day of the Roll-off at Logan City Tenpin Bowl.
- Games fees of \$50.00 are applicable at the 2nd Roll-off at Caboolture.

PROCEDURE AND PENALTIES

1. **COMPETITOR**

Any person competing in an event who is alleged to have contravened this Policy will be subject to the following action being taken at the time of the infraction: First Infraction: The offender will be given an official verbal warning. Second Infraction: A YELLOW CARD will be shown. Third Infraction: A RED CARD will be shown. The penalty for a third infraction is disqualification for the remainder of the Tournament or that session of League bowling and a possible suspension from future TBA competitions. The League or Tournament Committee must convene at a convenient time within 24 hours of the RED CARD being shown to discuss the need for further action to be taken under Chapter 5. If, in the opinion of the Tournament Director and/or Tournament Committee an incident is considered to be a very serious breach of the Code, then a Yellow or Red Card may be issued immediately without having followed the stated previous warning procedures.

2. OFFICE BEARER, TEAM OFFICIAL: Any person serving on any committee or Board, regardless of the level of the committee or Board within the Company who is alleged to have contravened this Policy will be subject to the following action being taken: Immediate removal from the position held. The relevant Board or committee that the officer is associated with must convene a hearing as soon as possible following the infraction to investigate the infraction and discuss the need for further action to be taken.

3. TBA REGISTERED BOWLER NOT INVOLVED IN THE EVENT: The Association/Registered bowling centre that the person is registered with will be advised of the infraction and they must convene a hearing as soon as possible following that advice to investigate the infraction and discuss the need for further action to be taken.

4. FOR A NON TBA PERSON: Centre Management and/or Tournament Officials should ask the offenders to leave the location. If the person refuses, put the matter into the hands of the Police and ask them to remove the offender.

5. In each of the clauses shown above, a detailed report must be submitted to the TBA CEO.

6. All State/Territory Associations have the right to carry out their own investigation into any alleged infringement and impose any penalty deemed necessary, regardless of whether any Centre or Association has imposed any penalties.

7. TBA reserves the right to carry out its own investigation and impose any penalty deemed necessary in addition to any State/Territory Association, Centre or Association penalties imposed.

8. TBA has the right to immediately remove any person serving on any Board, Committee or Association formed for the organisation or management of tenpin bowling from that Board, Committee or Association if TBA believes that the person has contravened this Code. In that instance, TBA will instigate a hearing based on the procedures set out in Chapter 5 (if required) of the TBA Rule Book as soon as possible after the action is taken. The TBA Board or a Committee appointed by that Board will hear any charge or charges and any defence applicable to the alleged contravention of the Code.

9. Tribunals appointed under the Member Protection Policy have the power to impose penalties defined in Attachment C6 of that policy.
