

# Nomination Form for Queensland State Teams 2010

Queensland Bowlers are advised that in 2010, ONE Roll Off will be held to select the State Teams to compete in the Walter Rachuig, National Seniors Challenge, and National Restricted Challenge at the 2010 Australian National Championships at Rooty Hill NSW in October 2010.

In fairness to all competitors across the State, the roll off will be held in an area as central as possible to ALL Queensland Bowlers, and as such, it will be at the Mackay Leisure Centre, 95 Broadsound Rd Mackay.

All bowlers will complete an 18 game roll off over the weekend of 20<sup>th</sup> and 21<sup>st</sup> February 2010 – 12 games on Saturday and 6 on Sunday, with the lane pattern changing every 6 games. The Lane patterns will be decided upon by the State Coaching Director, Gail Torrens, in consultation with the Technicians at Mackay Leisure Centre.

At the conclusion of Sundays' play, ALL teams will be announced, and team members will be required to participate in a briefing before they leave for their respective journeys home.

Check-in will CLOSE for all roll off divisions at 8.15am on Saturday 20<sup>th</sup> February, and bowling will commence at 8.30am. It is estimated that Sunday's play will commence at 9am however this time will be confirmed at the end of the first days play.

We have a guaranteed allocation of \$2500 prize money to be split equally amongst the 24 persons selected for the 4 Rachuig Teams only. Additional prize money will be allocated from nomination fees and this will be awarded to the top finishers regardless of final selection. This additional prize money will be dependant on the number of entrants.

## **TBAQ SELECTION CRITERIA**

### **QUEENSLAND RACHUIG TEAM SELECTION 2010**

#### **Guidelines for Selection**

- **Bowlers self nominate – by Wednesday 17th February 2010. Late nominations will not be accepted.**
- **Bowlers will provide a resume of recent bowling experiences.**
- **Bowlers are required to bowl in an 18 game roll off to be held on the 20th & 21st February 2010 at Mackay Leisure Centre.**
- **The top 20 men and the top 20 women bowlers on pinfall from the Roll off at Mackay will make up the Queensland Rachuig Squad. From that group of 20, 6 men and 6 women will be selected to make up the Queensland Rachuig team, and a further 6 men and 6 women will be selected to make up the Queensland Invitational Rachuig team (Qld A)**
- **All entrants must be TBA members in good standing and comply with the respective TBA Rules. Rachuig entrants please refer to Rachuig Rules V4.1 05.01.10 with particular attention to Rule 6. All bowlers must bowl league in a registered Queensland centre for 2010.**
- **Must bowl All Events in their respective 2010 Queensland Championships (State Championships at Caboolture, May, or NQ Zone Championships at Cairns in June).**
- **All selected bowlers will be required to sign off on the TBA Bowlers Code of Conduct and complete an ASADA workshop after selection.**
- **Bowlers must be available for training sessions (can be either NQ or SQ) as advised by the Coach or the Co-ordinator. Training outcomes and work ethic are considered when appointing final positions in teams. Team preparation will be a minimum of three sessions with the appointed coach. The first session will be as a group over a two day week-end format.**

#### **Spokespeople**

**With regard to any media or Rachuig Team information, TBAQ have authorised the Rachuig Co-ordinator Morty Douglas or TBAQ Vice President Broni Morgan as spokespersons.**

**Team Selection criteria:**

- **Bowlers to submit a resume of last 12 months experience  
OR best last three performances (if a recent 12 month report not possible). Include event name, date, placing, pinfall, number of games and average.**
- **Latest TBA ranking position for 2009 if registered.**
- **Performance in the 18 game Rachuig roll off will be recorded for selectors as follows:**
  - **Overall average & pinfall**
  - **Consistent performance**
- **Commitment to training dates as advised by coaches.**

**Roll Off Exemptions:**

**An occasion may arise whereby a bowler is unable to attend the Rachuig Roll Off as set down by this nomination form, however would still like to be in contention for a place in the squad of 20. Whilst it is preferable that ALL nominees attend the roll off, TBAQ are practical enough to know that this is not always possible. ANY bowler seeking to be exempted from participating in the 18 game event, needs to submit a written request for exemption to the State Adult Committee.**

**The application should contain full bowler details as per the nomination form, Rachuig nomination fee and detailed reason as to why the exemption is required. VERIFIABLE CONFIRMATION MUST BE ATTACHED, IE MEDICAL CERTIFICATE, LETTER FROM EMPLOYER etc. The Adult committee *will* verify any request received prior to making the information available to the State Team Selectors, who will have the final say. Should the request be denied, then Rachuig nomination fees will be refunded.**

**IT SHOULD BE NOTED THAT IF YOU DO NOT PARTICIPATE IN THE ROLL OFF, THEN YOU ARE NOT ELIGIBLE TO BE DRAFTED INTO ANOTHER STATE TEAM. (Rule 1.1 – TBA draft player policy)**

**Reserves**

**The 8 reserves for the Ladies and Men's teams will be asked to attend training as arranged by the Team Coaches. Training output will seed the reserves into position to be accepted by the Invitational team should reserves be called for in the State Team or Invitational Team.**

## **SENIORS TEAM SELECTION 2010**

### **BOWLER INFORMATION:**

- **Bowlers will self nominate - by Wednesday 17th February 2010. No nominations will be accepted.**
- **All bowlers must be current TBA members in good standing and comply with TBA Rules. Refer to NSTC Rules V2 5.01.10, Rule 6 in particular.**
- **All bowlers are required to bowl league in a registered Queensland centre for 2010.**
- **All bowlers must attain the age of fifty (50) years or over in the year of the competition.**
- **Bowlers will be required to bowl in an 18 game roll off to be held on the 20th and 21st February 2010 at Mackay Leisure Centre.**
- **The Top 4 bowlers (male and female) on scratch pinfall will be deemed the Queensland Seniors Challenge Team (Q1). The next 4 bowlers (male and female) will be deemed the Queensland Invitational Team (Q2). Those bowlers placed 9<sup>th</sup> and beyond will be reserves for the team, and as such MAY be required to fill in any vacancies within either Q1 or Q2 should they arise.**
- **All bowlers MUST bowl All Events in the 2010 Qld State Championships at Caboolture in May OR the North Queensland Zone Championships at Cairns in June 2010.**
- **All bowlers will be required to sign off on a Bowlers Code of Conduct and complete an ASADA workshop.**

## **QUEENSLAND RESTRICTED TEAM SELECTION 2010**

### **BOWLER INFORMATION:**

- **Bowlers will self nominate by Wednesday 17th February 2010. No late nominations will be accepted.**
- **All bowlers must be current TBA members in good standing and comply with the respective TBA Rules. Refer to NRTC Rules, V1.7, 5.01.10, Rule 6 in particular.**
- **All bowlers are required to bowl league in a registered Queensland centre for 2010.**
- **Bowlers intending to roll off for the Restricted Challenge Team will need to have an average as at 31/12/09 of 184 or less for men, and 174 or less for women. This average cut off also applies to any averages obtained from touring leagues, i.e. Twin Tour and ATBSO etc. League printouts verifying end of year averages MUST be attached to nomination forms. Failure to do so will result in bowlers playing off with handicap apportioned to the 184/174 average cut off, regardless of their actual average.**
- **Bowlers will bowl in an 18 game roll off to be held on the 20th and 21st February 2010 at Mackay Leisure Centre.**
- **Bowlers' total pinfall from the 18 games plus handicap (100% of 200, as per the national event) will determine final standings in the roll off. The top 4 bowlers (male and female) on handicap pinfall roll off will be deemed the Queensland Restricted Challenge Team (Q1). The next 4 bowlers (male and female) will be deemed the Queensland Invitational Team (Q2). Those bowlers placed from 9th will be reserves for the team, and as such MAY be required to fill in any vacancies within either Q1 or Q2 should they arise.**
- **All bowlers MUST bowl All Events in the 2010 Qld State Championships at Caboolture in May OR the 2010 North Queensland Zone Championships at Cairns in June.**
- **All bowlers will be required to sign off on a Bowlers Code of Conduct and complete an ASADA workshop.**
