## RULES AND INFORMATION

- 1. THREE GAME SERIES:** in each grade, each entrant will bowl three games.
- In the Teams (1 Division only- 3 person – any combination), Doubles (1 Division only - any combination) and Singles (Separate Male & Female & Aided Bowler Divisions). The highest scratch three game series (plus handicap in aided Division) to win in each event. The Divisions will be graded (except aided). A bowlers entering average will determine their grade.
- 3. ELIGIBILITY:** (Who may compete) This contest is open to all members holding an current TBA membership card who qualify as having a condition that is acknowledged by one of the following sporting bodies:-  
Ausrapid, Special Olympics Australia, Australian Sports Organisation for the Disabled, Cerebral Palsy Sports Recreation , Federation of Australia, Wheelchair Sports Australia, Australian Blind Sports Federation, Transplant Australia, Deaf Sports Australia  
**Special consideration can be given should a TBA registered bowler not fit the criteria of any of the above organisations. All appeals should be lodged in writing and forwarded to the Tournament Director.**
- 4. CLOSING DATES FOR ENTRIES:** All entries are to be accompanied by the full amount of entry fees and must reach the Tournament Director no later than **Friday 30<sup>th</sup> March 2012**.
- 5. SPECIAL NOTE:** If a Bowler uses Special Equipment to aid in delivering the ball then their average must be established using that equipment. *Bowlers who require the use of a mechanical or other aide in competition must ensure that they declare this need on their entry form to ensure that the aid is available.* Those bowlers who receive full assistance in the aiming and/or delivery of the bowling ball are required to enter the special aided bowlers division of this tournament.
- 6. CUT OFF DATE FOR ESTABLISHING AVERAGES:** Averages must have been established in a league or tournament, playing to a regular schedule, prior to midnight 31<sup>st</sup> December 2011.
- 7. WHICH AVERAGE TO USE:** Players are to use their highest current licensed league or tournament average gained over a minimum of eighteen (18) games. If insufficient games have been bowled in the current league season, then the yearbook average as at 31<sup>st</sup> December 2011 is to be used.
- 8. BOWLERS WITHOUT AN AVERAGE:** A Bowler, who has no average over eighteen (18) games in accordance with Rules 6 & 7, must apply to the Tournament Director for average classification prior to submitting an entry. If no application is made then the entering average will be the minimum required for Open Grade. The Tournament Director has the right to re-grade any Bowler or Entry.
- 9. PRIZES:** In every grade a trophy will be presented to the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place getters. A presentation will take place at the Centre at the completion of bowling.
- 10. REPLACEMENTS / CHANGES:** All replacements and changes to the original entry must be submitted to the Tournament Committee at least 60 minutes before the time scheduled to bowl.
- 11. ALL-EVENTS:** A Bowlers first appearance in Teams, Doubles and Singles will become their All Events score. A bowlers entering average in the Singles Grade will determine grades.
- 12. MULTIPLE PARTICIPATION - TEAMS:** A bowler may have multiple entries but with a least one (1) different bowler in each team.
- 13. DOUBLES:** A person may bowl four (4) times. The entries can be with the same or different partner for each event. (Four (4) entries maximum per bowler.)
- 14. SINGLES:** Contestants may bowl twice in their own graded division and twice in a higher division. Bowlers of Open Grade & the Aided Division may bowl four times in their division. Four (4) entries maximum per bowler.
- 15. SPECIAL NOTE:** The Tournament Director, whose decision shall be final, will decide any matters that may arise and which are not covered by these rules.

**17. MASTERS TOURNAMENT** Qualifying for this Tournament will be based on a persons 3 games of Bowling in the Championships with a 100% handicap added to all scores. The top 12 Men and top 12 Women will contest the finals to be played on Sunday 15<sup>th</sup> April 2012 at 2.00pm. 4 games will be played in the finals, with the top 3 players then playing a stepladder final. Cost of Qualifying is \$2 per attempt and the Finals will cost \$18.00 per finalist
