## **Eligibility:**

1. Must not have reached eighteen (18) on the 1<sup>st</sup> January 2016.
2. Must be a current financial member of a TBA licensed association or registered bowling centre in the South Queensland zone. TBA Registered Player cards, or proof of purchase, must be shown at check-in on day one.
3. Must have competed in at least eight weeks of league competition and bowled a minimum of 24 games in a TBA or structured League in the South Queensland Zone, during the current year. League games completed post/pre bowl do not count towards the number of games bowled.
4. Must reside in South Queensland Zone for a period of time that enables participation in the Roll-Off and if successful in making the team must continue league play in a TBA or structured league. Requests for exemption to this rule must be in writing to the TBA (refer TBA eligibility criteria).
5. Be capable of conduct that does not adversely affect TBA of the State of QLD.

## **Nominations:**

- All entries must be received **no later than Friday 10<sup>th</sup> July 2015**. No entries after this date will be accepted. Please include proof of payment.

## **Format**

- Qualifying will be held in two divisions, Boys and Girls. A total of 16 games (8 games per day) will be completed in a 5-person team format where possible.
- Selection of President's Shield Team  
At the conclusion of the roll-off, the 5 highest pinfall bowlers in the roll-off in both Boys and Girls Divisions will be declared as members of the South Queensland President's Shield Team. In the event of a tie for 5<sup>th</sup> place, there will be a one game tiebreaker to decide the position. A further two will be selected for each Division. Based on injury or illness before or during the roll-off, the Committee reserves the right to select the 6th/7th bowler providing all of the criteria have been met.
- Selection of Development Squad – to be confirmed  
A Development Squad will be selected by the Committee.

The final South Queensland Team and Development Squad will travel to Keon Park in Melbourne, Victoria to participate in the 2016 National Championships.

## **Selection Criteria:**

- All nominees are required to attach a detailed resume of their personal bowling achievements for consideration by the Selectors.
- All bowlers must be in good financial standing with TBAQ with no outstanding debts.
- The selectors will take into consideration bowler's performance during the roll-off, together with past participation and results in regional, state and national events.

Selection Guidelines (as provided for in paragraph 4.0 of TBA's State Team Selection Policy):

- a) those bowlers who finished in 6th and 7th positions should be selected, unless:
  - i) there is ample evidence that another bowler in the selection pool has a better history relating to average, ability, team performance or any other qualification deemed relevant.
  - ii) the Committee must be prepared to supply the unsuccessful person/s in writing with the reason for their non-selection.
- b) if any exemption applications have been received and exemption granted, those participants must be included in the selection pool.
- c) a participant granted an exemption may not have participated in all or part of the roll-off or selection process, so the State must define what new criteria will be used when making their selections. The part of the process the exemption was granted for should not be taken into consideration.

Appeals Process (in accordance with paragraph 5.0 of TBA's State Team Selection Policy):

- a) Any bowler who nominates for a position as a part of the 2016 Queensland President Shield team and is not successful may lodge an appeal against their non-selection.
- b) This initial appeal must be lodged in writing and received within 24 hours after the announcement of the team or position.

- c) Should an appeal be lodged, the status of the announced team or position remains unconfirmed until the appeals process has been completed.
- d) Appeals in the first instance should be lodged with the Sth Qld Jnr Tenpin Committee.
- e) Should the appellant be dissatisfied with the answer received from the Committee, they should lodge a further appeal with TBAQ within seven (7) days of the receipt of the Committee's written decision. Such appeal will be dealt with by TBAQ's Appeals Panel for this purpose, comprising Mr Trevor Gilliland and Ms Gail Torrens.
- f) Should the appellant be dissatisfied with the answer received from TBAQ, they should lodge a further and final appeal with TBA within seven (7) days of receipt of TBAQ's written decision.
- g) All communications between the appellant and the relevant Committee must be in writing. Alleged verbal communications will not be taken into consideration in any appeals.
- h) Only those persons comprising the Appeals Panel will be permitted to sit on the panel. Others with relevant information can be called to address the panel with their witness statements. Persons associated with the original selection will not be permitted to make any attempt to sway the appeals process, either by communicating with the Independent Panel members or addressing the panel prior to any proceedings taking place where that person is called to give testimony.

### **Fees Payable:**

An estimated cost of \$2,500 up to \$3,200, will be required by all President Shield Team and Development Squad bowlers who travel with the team to the 2016 Nationals. This is an estimated cost and participation in fundraising activities can reduce this amount. Bowlers who make the 2016 President Shield Team and Development Squad are required to pay a deposit of \$500 by Monday 17<sup>th</sup> August 2015. Please note that fundraising may be used to cover the costs of the Coaches and Managers. A schedule of payments will be supplied to team members.

### **Failure to make progressive payments by the due dates WILL result in the forfeiture of your place in the team.**

### **Conditions:**

1. No entries will be accepted unless the form is:
  - Signed by the bowler and their parent/guardian.
2. All parents/legal guardians agree by signing the Entry Form that they accept the following rules and conditions when their child becomes a member of the South Queensland Team or Development Squad.
  - Deposit the initial fee of \$500 (non-refundable) to the nominated bank account of the South Queensland Junior Committee by Monday 17<sup>th</sup> August 2015.
  - Pay all other monies in excess of the \$500 in installments on the due dates set out by the Committee.
  - Abide by all rules and any instructions given by the Committee and its delegated officials at any function, tournament or training session.
  - Successful members of the 2016 President's Shield team will be required to be TBA Silver members.
3. The parent/legal guardian will ensure that the bowler will:
  - Attend and be punctual at all official training sessions as designated by the Coaches. A training schedule will be implemented by the coaches and comprise compulsory training sessions and tournaments.
  - Attend all uniform fitting sessions and wear the official training/team uniform when directed.
  - Travel with the team as requested by the team management.
  - Actively participate in all fundraising activities and events set by the Committee.

## **Rules of Conduct:**

These rules of conduct will apply to the South Queensland President's Shield Team roll-off competitors and the eventual 2016 representative team and squad members. This code of conduct is to be read in conjunction with the TBA Rules and Regulations.

- All TBA rules and regulations will apply including the TBA Code of Ethics.
- Bowlers must remain in the playing area until all play is completed.
- No food or drink in the playing area.
- Any bowler failing to complete the roll-off will not be entitled to a refund of any monies paid, and will be considered as withdrawing from the event. Bowlers withdrawing due to injury or illness will remain eligible for selection.
- Bowlers must wear neat, acceptable bowling attire, collared shirt, dress pants for boys and dress pants/shorts or skirts for girls. No caps, half/three quarter length pants, jeans, cargo pants or sport style tops will be acceptable.
- Smoking and alcohol are prohibited during a series or session of continuous games in any competition accredited by TBA or any organisation, Committee or Bowling Centre recognised by TBA.
- Mobile phones, IPODs, MP3s etc are NOT permitted in the players' area, and must be switched off whilst bowling.
- Bowlers must always conduct themselves in a polite manner. No bad or offensive language is to be used and bowlers will refrain from kicking or otherwise abusing the ball returns or equipment. Unsportsmanlike remarks will NOT be tolerated.
- At no time will a deliberate foul be accepted.
- All reasonable instructions given by the team managers or coaches are to be carried out.
- All bowlers should be aware of, and will be subjected to, all ASADA policies, guidelines and penalties.
- **NO bowler and/or their family members/coaches shall use electronic media, such as Facebook, Totalbowling, Twitter etc to defame or make derogatory remarks about any individual, selector, organisation or association such as TBA, TBAQ or SQJTBC.**
- All rules must be adhered to, or person/persons can be reprimanded and/or brought before a committee where possible suspension and exclusion from further participation may result.
- When representing Queensland, any bowler contravening these rules will be sent home at their own expense forfeiting all monies.
- Any bowler not conforming to the rules of conduct will have their right to represent Queensland revoked and will forfeit all monies.
- Any serious breach of these rules may result in automatic disqualification from bowling in any State Team Trials.
- Applications for exemption to any rules, or eligibility criteria, are to be in writing to the Secretary, South Queensland Junior Tenpin Bowling Committee, and received no later than Friday 10<sup>th</sup> July 2015. **An exemption will only be considered due to an injury or medical condition. An exemption application should contain a completed Nomination Form, a Medical Certificate and proof of payment of the nomination fee. If the exemption application is denied, the entry fee will be refunded.**

As per paragraph 3.1 of TBA's State Team Selection Policy, all applications for exemption to the State must be in writing and all replies to the participant by the State will be in writing.
