***RESPONSIBILITIES: The successful applicant should –***

1. Meet with the QATBC on as required to discuss budget and related matters.
2. Enhance the skills and levels of excellence already displayed by bowlers who gain a place in either the Rachuig, Seniors, Youth or Restricted Queensland team.
3. Impact a positive attitude towards winning for members of all Teams.
4. Together with the committee arrange all practice sessions and with the manager communicate these with the team and individuals.
5. Be prepared to conduct training sessions at various locations.
6. Liaise with manager to direct the time of the Ball Registration forms prior to the event.
7. Decide team line-ups during the Rachuig, Seniors, Youth and Restricted Competition.
8. Be aware that they will be required to wear the state uniform as decided on by the committee, help organise and participate in all fundraising events run to assist the teams.
9. Have obtained a copy and clearly understand the TBAQ Member Protection Policy 2002 and the TBA Coaches Code of Ethics, Rachuig, Seniors, Youth or Restricted rules – regulations/requirements. (Available on either the TBAQ or TBA website)
10. Be responsible for all aspects of behaviour, conduct, standard of dress of the State team members in your team.
11. Be authorised to drive a team bus if required whilst at the National tournament.
12. Assist with snack preparation during Nationals.
13. Be prepared to submit a written report to the QATBC within 4 weeks of returning from the National tournament.
14. Be required to address any written complaints received regarding the coaches' performance in relation to the responsibilities and code of conduct while coach of the team.
15. ***Please note this trip is SELF-FUNDED. Costs can be reduced by fundraising.***

***EXPERIENCE***

It is preferred that the successful applicants are accredited TBA Silver Level Coaches for Rachuig and Youth and TBA accredited Bronze level coaches for Seniors and Restricted. If no TBA Silver Level Coaches apply a TBA Bronze Accredited Coach will be considered under the guidance of a TBA Silver Level Coach for Rachuig.
