We are currently seeking expressions of interest for the position of the 2016 South Queensland Development Squad Coach and/or Manager. Dependant on the number of applicants and their experience, this position/s may be filled by one or two people.

RESPONSIBILITIES: The successful applicant should –

1. Meet with the SQJTBC on a regular basis.
2. Enhance the skills and levels of excellence already displayed by bowlers who gain a place in the Development Squad.
4. Together with the Committee arrange all Practice Sessions and with the Manager communicate these with the team and individuals.
5. Be prepared to conduct training sessions at various locations.
6. Approve, supervise and if necessary veto all activities that may interfere or react with peak player performance while in preparation and while away at the Nationals.
7. Collect signed code of behaviour forms and medical forms.
8. Arrange for shirts to be washed.
9. In conjunction with the rest of the Management Team, provide all meals, snacks and drinks for the duration of the stay ensuring healthy options in line with the teachings from the State Based Training Squad and the balance of meals is nutritious. It is recommended that there are more cooked meals rather than meals eaten out.
10. Be aware that they will be required to wear the State Uniform as decided on by the committee, help organise and participate in all fundraising events run to assist the Teams.
11. Be responsible for all aspects of behaviour, conduct, standard of dress of the SQ Junior Development Squad from departure to return from the Tournament.
12. Be authorised to drive the team bus whilst at the National Tournament.
13. Be prepared to submit a written report to the SQJTBC within 4 weeks of returning from the National Competition.
14. Be required to address any written complaints received regarding the coaches/managers performance in relation to the responsibilities and code of conduct while coach/manager of the team.
15. ***Please note this trip is SELF-FUNDED. Costs can be reduced by fundraising.***
